ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Community Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety Training (CPBST) program is a joint project of [UC Berkeley Safe Transportation Research and Education Center](#) (SafeTREC) and [California Walks](#) (Cal Walks). Funding for this program is provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA). This year's CPBST program will run from October 2022 to September 2023.

The program works with local residents and safety advocates to develop a community-driven action plan to improve walking and biking safety in their communities. The program aims to help communities:

- Increase their knowledge of pedestrian and bicyclist safety;
- Identify Safe System strategies to implement in their community to improve safety for all road users; and
- Strengthen rapport between residents, local officials, agency staff, and other partners.

Each community will plan and attend a free community-wide workshop. The workshop helps strengthen collaboration between all safety partners and is adapted to meet a community's needs. It consists of:

- A facilitated discussion on local crash data and the community's safety experiences;
- A walking / biking assessment to identify safety concerns and opportunities for improvements;
- An educational overview of the Safe System framework and strategies; and
- An interactive activity to develop a community-driven safety action plan.

We recognize that the COVID-19 pandemic has had a significant impact on communities statewide and created challenges for community planning. We are committed to working with communities about how best to protect health and safety throughout this process. We will follow guidelines issued by the CDC, California Department of Public Health, and local ordinances as they apply to your community.

Eligible project applicants include:

- Community-based organizations, community groups, and coalitions;
- Schools, school districts; and
- Local city and county agencies, tribal governments.
