Strategies and Opportunities

Strategies

- ▶ First, listen to the community
 - Community voices may provide your strongest argument
 - Form local institutions or seek to work with existing ones
- ▶ Use every level of government available
 - Local, County, Regional (RTPA/MPO), State, Federal
 - Agencies and Elected Officials are different!
- ▶ Look into intersecting topics
 - Public health departments

Grants and Programs

- ▶ Start with your county and local government (if present)
- ▶ Regional (RTPA/MPO)
 - Quite a few MPOs support active transportation planning
- ▶ State
 - OTS, ATP, many other grants
- ▶ Non-governmental organizations
 - AARP challenge grants
 - Other kinds of private partnerships
